

# SPAY & NEUTER SERVICES

All animals are required to be up-to-date on vaccinations prior to scheduling surgery. *If your animal has been vaccinated, please provide documentation with your application.*

Minimum Age = 12 Weeks  
Minimum Weight = 3 lbs

## UNVACCINATED ANIMAL FEES

These prices include an exam, a DAPP or FVRCP vaccine, a Rabies vaccine, & the surgery. Heartworm tests will be given to dogs older than 7 months.

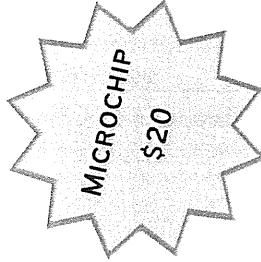

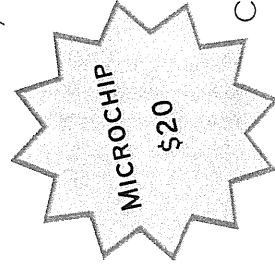

# ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for our services, pet owners must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Provide proof of low income status and fall within 150% of the Federal Poverty Line as defined by the U.S. Federal Poverty Guideline.

OR

- Provide proof of assistance from one of the following state programs:

KanCare SSI/SSDI  
Medicaid Medicare  
TANF SNAP  
WIC

# CLINIC GOALS

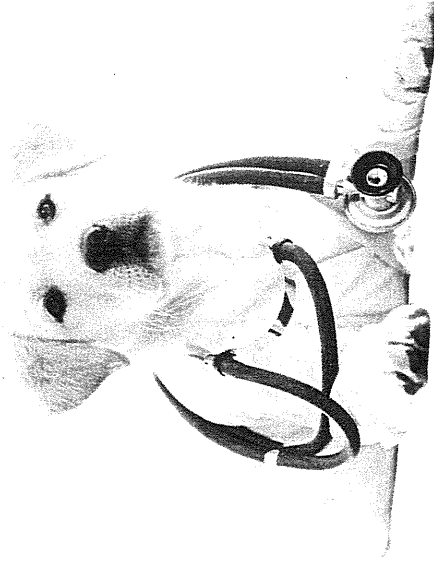
To decrease the number of animals entering the shelter—either as strays or surrendered by owners by reducing the number of unwanted litters.

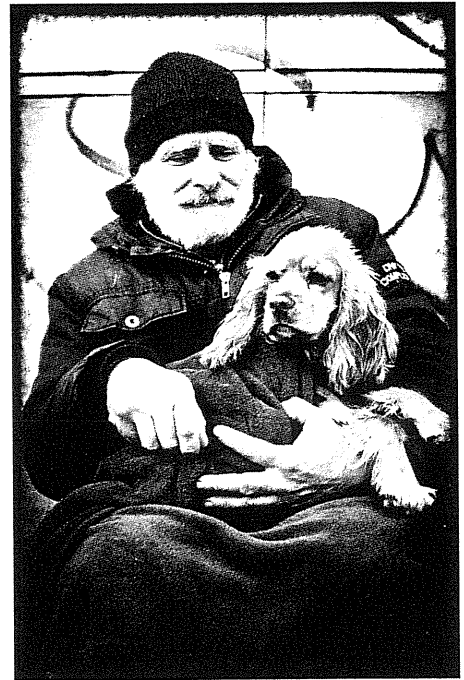
